FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS?

HOW LONG DOES THE APPLICATION PROCESS TAKE?

Once submitted, the process can take six to eight weeks, depending on the extent of your background.

DO I NEED TO BE LICENSED TO APPLY?

YES. Applicants must possess a current and unrestricted Texas Peace Officer's license or be immediately licensable by TCOLE upon appointment.

HOW LONG IS THE ACADEMY?

The academy is approximately nine weeks long.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER GRADUATION?

Graduates from the Academy are sworn in as probationary police officers. Once they successfully pass the seven-week field training period they will be assigned to a patrol shift based on seniority.
