SAT Continues to Break Monthly Passenger Records

SUMMARY

In August 2023, the airport's passenger numbers reached 883,660. SAT once again broke a monthly passenger record with this August being the busiest in the airport's history. The previous record was set in August 2018. Compared to the year prior, 2022, passenger numbers for August were up nearly 9%.

The airport continues to compare its numbers to those in 2019 to better understand its recovery. 2019 was a record year for the airport with more than 10 million passengers flying through the terminals. Passenger levels seen during August 2023 were 1% higher than the same month in 2019. When looking at the total traffic seen during the summer months (May through August), SAT's passenger numbers reached 3,765,721 which represented an increase of 2.5% compared to the same period in 2019.

Airlines continue to add capacity to the San Antonio market. Several airlines flew more seats to San Antonio this month than the same month in 2019. The airlines with the largest increases in service included Aeromexico (AM), Delta Air Lines (DL), Southwest Airlines (WN), United Airlines (UA), and Volaris (Y4). Additionally, new airlines began flying from San Antonio since 2019 including JetBlue Airways (B6), Spirit Airlines (NK), and VivaAerobus (VB).

Additionally, a total of 21,241,975 pounds of air cargo moved through SAT during the month of August 2023. This is below levels seen during the same month in both 2022 and 2019. For more detailed information see the included charts.



Upcoming Changes

Nonstop service to San Diego (SAN) on Southwest Airlines (WN) will increase to 2x daily beginning on October 5th.

American Airlines (AA) will increase nonstop service to Dallas-Ft. Worth (DFW) to 13x daily on October 5th. Not only does this give passengers more options to the Dallas-Ft. Worth region, but easier one-stop options to destinations throughout the world via American's hub at DFW.

American Airlines (AA) will add a 4th daily flight to Phoenix (PHX) beginning October 5th. This increase will bring the total daily flights to Phoenix (PHX) to 8 including 4 daily flights on Southwest Airlines (WN).

Southwest Airlines (WN) seasonal service to Colorado Springs (COS) will resume on November 21st. Service will operate on Saturdays through December and daily on days around the holidays.

History will be made on May 17, 2024, as Condor Airlines (DE) launches San Antonio's first-ever trans-Atlantic service to Frankfurt (FRA). Service will operate seasonally until September 6, 2024 during this first season, and will operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

American Airlines (AA) will launch daily, nonstop service to Philadelphia (PHL) starting June 5th.



DOMESTIC PASSENGERS

SAT continues to compare passenger numbers to 2019 levels to better understand and monitor the recovery. Total scheduled domestic capacity, or seats, were up 7% compared to 2019 levels while domestic passenger numbers were down slightly by less than a percentage point compared to August 2019.

Several airlines flew more passengers during August 2023 than the same month in 2019 showing not only recovery but significant growth in our market. These include Delta Air Lines (DL) and United Airlines (UA) who both experienced passenger growth compared to August 2019. While not exceeding 2019 levels, Southwest Airlines (WN) flew 94% of their 2019 levels.


New airlines have contributed to these numbers including both JetBlue Airways (B6) and Spirit Airlines (NK) which both have launched nonstop service from SAT to various cities since the pandemic.


The following routes had more capacity this month than in August 2019:

- American Airlines (AA) to Charlotte (CLT) and Miami (MIA).
- Delta Air Lines (DL) to Detroit (DTW), Los Angeles (LAX), Minneapolis-St. Paul (MSP), and Salt Lake City (SLC).
- Southwest Airlines (WN) to Baltimore (BWI), Denver (DEN), El Paso (ELP), Kansas City (MCI), Nashville (BNA), Orlando (MCO), Phoenix (PHX), and Tampa (TPA).
- United Airlines (UA) to Denver (DEN), Houston (IAH), Newark (EWR), San Francisco (SFO), and Washington (IAD).

INTERNATIONAL PASSENGERS

An impressive increase in both international capacity and passengers to and from SAT has helped recovery at the airport. SAT's scheduled international capacity increased by 46% when compared to August 2019 while international passenger numbers increased by 28%.

All the airlines that operate international service from SAT added more seats to the market than in August 2019. Much of this increase in capacity was a result of pandemic closures to the land border. Since its reopening, demand and capacity has remained higher than pre-pandemic levels at SAT indicating that many travelers have decided to fly rather than drive to and from Mexico.


SAT ranked #1 among all U.S. medium-hub airports in terms of total seats to Mexico for August 2023. When looking at all U.S. airports, SAT ranked #12 between Orlando (MCO) and Newark (EWR). In terms of total international seats, SAT ranked #34 out of all 69 U.S. airports that had international service during August.


When comparing year-over-two-year international capacity changes, the results were based on the following:

- Aeromexico (AM) increasing frequency from daily to two/three times daily to Mexico City (MEX).
- Southwest (WN) increasing capacity on Cancun (CUN) nonstops and expanding the service year-round.
- Sun Country (SY) beginning nonstop service to Cancun (CUN) in 2021 and increasing frequencies in 2022.
- VivaAerobus (VB) entering the market with nonstop service to Leon/Guanajuato (BJX), Mexico City (MEX), and Monterrey (MTY).
- Volaris (Y4) nearly doubling their frequencies to both Guadalajara (GDL) and Mexico City (MEX).
